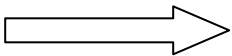

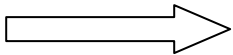

NEW EQUIPMENT: The supplier certifies that the product shall be new and latest model in current production. Used, shopworn, demonstrator, prototype, or discontinued models are not acceptable.

PALLET SIZE REQUIREMENT: When required, goods shall be palletized and stacked no higher than 52 inches in height, including pallet. Goods shall be placed on size 42" x 42", Size 2, Type 2 pallets in accordance with State of California Specification #3990-01A-01, dated January 2001. If the product is palletized in any other format, the shipment will be refused and returned "FREIGHT COLLECT" to the originating supplier.
