NOTICE TO ALL BIDDERS:

Bids are to be submitted electronically through a secure mailbox via the Integrated Financial Resources Management System (INFORMS) (<https://supplier.miamidade.gov>) until the date and time indicated in the INFORMS Solicitation End Date published in INFORMS and in this Solicitation document. It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to ensure that its Bid is in INFORMS before the Solicitation deadline. There is no cost to the Bidder to submit a Bid for a Miami-Dade County Solicitation via INFORMS. Electronic submissions may require the uploading of electronic attachments. The submission of attachments containing embedded documents or proprietary file extensions is prohibited. All documents should be attached as separate files.

For information concerning this Solicitation, use the question/answer feature provided within the Solicitation by INFORMS at <https://supplier.miamidade.gov>. Questions of a material nature must be received prior to the date and time of the INFORMS Solicitation Question & Answer End Date specified in the Solicitation. Material changes, if any, to the Solicitation will be made only by written addendum. (See Mandatory Online Forms and Addendum Acknowledgement section of INFORMS site).

Bidders must allow sufficient time to complete online forms and upload all Bid documents. All information and documents must be fully entered, uploaded, acknowledged ("Confirm") and recorded into INFORMS before the date and time of the INFORMS Solicitation End Date, or the system will **stop** the process and the submission will be considered late and will not be accepted.

No part of a Bid can be submitted via hardcopy, email, or fax.

If you submit your bid and subsequently an Addendum is issued, failure to submit the bid again by clicking on the "Submit Bid" button, after acknowledging Addenda or editing your bid in INFORMS will result in your bid not being received by the County.

SECTION 2 **ADDITIONAL/SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

2.1 BACKGROUND

The County's Integrated Database Management System (CA IDMS) serves as the database management platform for the County's mainframe environment. The IDMS enables automated monitoring of database applications and facilitates integration across various systems. The Information Technology Department (ITD) relies on the IDMS to support many of the County's core mainframe applications.

The County requires ongoing access to software licenses, along with associated maintenance and support services for the Integrated Database Management System. CA IDMS is a high-performance, network-based database management system specifically designed for IBM mainframes. It offers robust database management and data manipulation capabilities, supporting complex data structures and high transaction volumes required by large-scale enterprise applications. For the full range of services required see section 3.2.

2.2 PURPOSE

The purpose of this solicitation is to establish a contract to provide software licenses, maintenance and support services for CA IDMS mainframe software products. The resultant contract will provide comprehensive database management and data manipulation capabilities, supporting complex data structures and high transaction volumes, commonly used in large-scale enterprise applications.

2.3 TERM OF CONTRACT

This Contract shall commence on the first calendar day of the month succeeding approval of the Contract by the Board of County Commissioners, or designee, unless otherwise stipulated in the Purchase Order issued by the County. The Contract shall expire on the last day of the 24-months.

2.4 METHOD OF AWARD

Award of this contract will be made to the responsive, responsible Bidder who submits an offer on all items listed in the solicitation and whose offer represents the lowest price when all items are added in the aggregate. If a Bidder fails to submit an offer on all items, its overall offer may be rejected.

2.5 BIDDER REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the requirements detailed in Section 1-General Terms and Conditions, Paragraph 1.2-Instructions to Bidders, the Bidder shall meet the following requirements to be considered for award:

2.5.1 Bidder or Bidder's Subcontractor shall be regularly engaged in the business of providing CA IDMS mainframe software products and services to be considered for award. Bidder or Bidder's Subcontractor shall provide two (2) different references from customers to whom the Bidder or Bidder's Subcontractor has provided or is currently providing CA critical mainframe software products and services as described throughout this Solicitation. In lieu of the references from the Bidder or Bidder's Subcontractor, the County will consider the references from Bidder's key personnel in accordance with Resolution No. 1122-21.

The references should include the customer's company name, and the contact person's name, title, address, telephone number, and e-mail address, who can verify that the Bidder/key personnel/Subcontractor has successfully provided the goods/services (Section 4: Submittal Requirements). These references shall ascertain to the County's satisfaction that the Bidder/key personnel/Subcontractor has sufficient expertise in the industry and its firm is properly equipped to perform the required goods/services.

2.5.2 Bidder or Bidder's Subcontractor shall provide documented proof confirming their authorization to provide software licenses, maintenance and support services to be considered for award. This proof may be provided as an official letter from OEM or any other verifiable document that demonstrates current active status as an authorized distributor/service provider.

The Bidder shall provide all the information, documents and/or attachments listed above to be considered for award. All information, documents, and/or attachments listed above are due with the Bid by the solicitation's end time and date. The County may, at its sole discretion and in its best interest, allow the Bidder to complete, supplement or supply the required information, documents and/or attachments during the bid evaluation period.

During the bid evaluation period, the County's Strategic Procurement Department will review the information, documents and/or attachments submitted by the Bidder, may request additional information from the Bidder, and/or obtain additional information from available sources, to completely evaluate the Bidder's submittal and ascertain that the Bidder meets the stipulated requirements and determine the Bidder's ability to perform under a resulting Contract. The County shall be sole judge of a Bidder's compliance with requirements and the Bidder's ability to perform under a resulting Contract. Failure to meet the stipulated requirements or to demonstrate ability to perform under a resulting Contract, as determined by the County, may result in the Bidder being declared non-responsible.

During a resulting Contract, the Bidder has an obligation to advise the County of any changes, intended or otherwise, to the evidence given in compliance with the requirements in this Solicitation.

2.6 PRICES

The prices proposed by the Bidder shall remain fixed and firm during the term of the contract

2.7 INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Section 1.22, Insurance Requirements, sub-section A is replaced in its entirety with the following:

A. The Awarded Bidder shall furnish to the Vendor Outreach & Support Services Section, 111 NW 1st Street, Suite 1300, Miami, Florida 33128, Certificate(s) of Insurance which indicates that insurance coverage has been obtained and meets the requirements as outlined below:

1. Commercial General Liability for \$1,000,000 each occurrence \$2,000,000 aggregate including Products/completed operations. **Miami-Dade County must be included as additional insured for any and all work**
2. Workers' compensation insurance as required by Florida Statute 440 or any applicable law
3. Automobile liability covering all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles for \$1,000,000 combined single limit.
4. Professional liability or Errors and Omissions insurance for \$5,000,000 each occurrence/aggregate covering claims arising out of the rendering or failure to render professional services or provision of products
5. Cyber Liability for \$5,000,000 each occurrence/aggregate

All insurance policies required above shall be issued by companies authorized to do business under the laws of the State of Florida, with the following qualifications:

The company must be rated no less than "A-" as to management, and no less than "Class VII" as to financial strength, by Best's Insurance Guide, published by A.M. Best Company, Oldwick, New Jersey, or its equivalent, subject to the approval of the County Risk Management Division.

Or

The company must hold a valid Florida Certificate of Authority as shown in the latest "List of All Insurance Companies Authorized or Approved to Do Business in Florida" issued by the State of Florida Department of Financial Services.

Miami-Dade County reserves the right, upon reasonable notice, to request and examine the policies of insurance (including but not limited to policies, binders, amendments, exclusions or riders, etc)

2.8 NO ALTERNATE BIDS ARE ALLOWED

No alternate bids are allowed. In Addition, the specific items listed in Section 3.2, "Equipment to be Provided," are the only products that will be accepted under this solicitation due to the nature of these items. "Equal" products shall not be considered by the County.

2.9 PURCHASE OF OTHER ITEMS NOT LISTED

It is understood that the County may purchase any additional software products and services, as a supplement to those awarded as a part of the resultant contract. The County reserves the right to purchase any existing or future product from the full Broadcom Product List. Under these circumstances, the Strategic Procurement Department will contact the Awarded Bidder to obtain a price quote for such items. Any future purchases may be subject to price negotiations. Any additional items shall be added to the contract via a formal written modification.

2.10 ACCESS TO BROADCOM PRODUCT LIST

The Parties recognize that, as an authorized reseller of Broadcom products and services, the awarded Bidder's ability to perform under EVN0033959 is subject to Broadcom's General Terms and Conditions for all authorized resellers (also available via link <https://www.broadcom.com/company/legal/licensing>).

The Parties also acknowledge that the County's ability to use Broadcom-branded products and services through this solicitation is conditioned on acceptance of the terms and conditions governing end users and the County may be required to execute necessary documentation to acknowledge same.

SECTION 3 SCOPE OF WORK/TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

3.1 SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of this project includes providing license, maintenance, and support for the following CA IDMS mainframe software products listed below:

- CA Mainframe Software Information
- License Type: Usage and Maintenance Fee (UMF)
- Operating System: Multiple Virtual Storage (MVS)

3.2 SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

1. **CA IDMS/DB for z/OS Plus:** A comprehensive database management solution for IBM z/OS mainframes, providing advanced capabilities for designing, managing, and optimizing IDMS databases. It ensures high performance, reliability, and scalability for enterprise-level applications running on z/OS.
2. **CA IDMS Schema Mapper Option:** A tool that aids in the visualization and management of database schemas within the CA IDMS environment. It allows users to create, view, and modify database schema diagrams, simplifying the management of database structures and relationships.
3. **CA Panvalet:** A source code management tool for IBM mainframes, CA Panvalet manages and controls software development assets. It provides version control, library management, and security features for source code, Job Control Language (JCL), and other development resources, ensuring organized and secure code management. **If and when this product is replaced, Broadcom will replace it with the new product, at no additional cost.**
4. **CA EDP Auditor:** This tool is designed for Electronic Data Processing (EDP) auditing on IBM mainframes. It helps auditors evaluate and ensure the accuracy, security, and efficiency of data processing activities and systems, offering tools for compliance, risk management, and operational integrity.
5. **CA Disk Backup and Restore MIPS:** A software solution designed for IBM mainframes, optimizing the process of backing up and restoring disk data. It focuses on efficient MIPS usage to minimize system resource consumption, ensuring fast and reliable data protection and recovery for critical enterprise environments.
6. **CA MIM Resource Sharing for z/OS Plus:** This software simplifies and automates the sharing of storage, tape devices, and system messages and commands, ensuring safe and efficient operations across multiple IBM z/OS, z/VM, and z/Linux systems.
7. **CA Dispatch MIPS:** A report distribution and management solution for IBM mainframes, designed to optimize MIPS usage. It efficiently handles the distribution, archiving, and retrieval of reports and documents, reducing the resource load on the mainframe and improving overall system performance.

The CA Software will be delivered electronically (ESD), with no tangible personal property being delivered.

Authorized Use

The Licensed Programs will be used solely by and for the benefit of the County, to process the County's data at the designated locations. The usage is confirmed by the Sub-Capacity Reports (SRT) provided to the awarded Bidder quarterly, ensuring that the Production MIPS Capacity does not exceed the specified limit of 1096 MIPS. Any increase in Licensed MIPS Capacity will be subject to CA's current pricing. The total MIPS shall not exceed 1,096 MIPS during the term. For SCRT reports, 8 MIPS is equal to 1 MSU, based on the IBM 60FE8 and 60FD8 Central Processing Unit (CPU).
